



Chapters are to remain **CLOSED** to the public, Birdsprings Chapter is currently providing **ONLY "ESSENTIAL GOVERNMENT FUNCTIONS"** and assisting with the implementation of the Emergency Navajo Nation Chapter Plan. The Birdsprings Chapter is approved for the following essential government services:

- Solid waste management services – done on **MONDAYS** at Little Singer Community School from 9 am to 3 pm (DST).
- Water hauling point services – done on **WEDNESDAYS** onsite at Birdsprings Chapter from 9 am to 1 pm (DST).
- Water hauling services to residence's homes – done on **FRIDAYS** with water truck to local community members homes from 9 am to 3 pm (DST).

No other services will be provided at this time. For any water delivery or services, please knock on the door and Mr. Randolph Billy will speak to you from the door. If loading up water outside, please stay in your vehicle while this service is being completed. The services noted above are temporary and fees for water will apply once the Chapters are reopened to the public.
